East Tennessee is steeped in history. The oldest frame house in Tennessee, the Carter Mansion, was the home of pioneers, John and Landon Carter, built between 1775 and 1780. Sycamore Shoals played a significant role in 18th century history as the setting for some of the most dramatic events to occur in the expansion of America's western boundary. The reconstructed Fort Watauga at



Sycamore Shoals State Historic Park features living history and acts as a backdrop to the annual production of Tennessee's official outdoor drama, Liberty!, a tribute to the nation's earliest settlement, The Watauga Association.

You can walk through history along the Overmountain Victory Trail to see where volunteer Revolutionary War heroes crossed the Watauga River to muster for King's Mountain, South Carolina, where the turning point of the Revolution was won. They will be on that trail Friday while you are in East Tennessee. The week-end before the reunion, they will be at the fort reconstructing and demonstrating 18th century times. So if you love history you will want to participate in these events.



Bristol is the birthplace of Country Music, Jonesboro is the oldest town in Tennessee and the Storytelling Capital of the World, and Greenville County close by is the birthplace of David Crockett. There is the Appalachian Trail, Blueridge Parkway, Grandfather Mountain, Bristol Caverns, Bristol Speedway, Linville Waterfalls, and you can even travel the trails of the first moonshiners. There

is something for everyone. Unicoi County close by was the setting for “The Last of the Mohicans”.
